## Hazel O'Sullivan (b. 1998)

Hazel O'Sullivan is a multi-disciplinary visual artist working in England and Ireland. Throughout her work she is drawn to household imagery and bold representations of the domestic sphere. As such, O'Sullivan's art explores the modernisation of traditional spaces through her stylistic retro-futuristic lens. Through much of her work, she uses mathematical perspectives to analyse perception and space, whilst also referring to motifs of mobility. In doing so, O'Sullivan interrogates the border between interior and exterior in the modern world. Her multi-disciplinary approach allows her to confront and dissect the themes she tackles through the symbols and textures they warrant.
